Students are required to report directly to the SUTD Sports & Recreation Centre by 8 AM, where attendance will be taken by their Homeroom Teachers. The events will commence promptly at 8.00 AM.

### **Guidelines for Students**

- Students will return to school-by-school bus at approximately 12.30 PM and will continue with their regular lessons after lunch. Please ensure they bring their school bags, books, and all materials required for their afternoon classes.
- Attendance at the Sports Heats is mandatory, and attendance will be recorded at the venue.
- Students should wear their House T-shirt, PE shorts, and PE shoes. Running spikes are optional for track events.
- Please ensure your child brings a water bottle, cap, sunscreen, snacks, and lunch in a small bag that they can carry to the venue.
- A map, directions, and public transport information for the venue are attached for your reference.
- Subject to weather conditions, the Heats are expected to conclude by 12.00 PM.
- Qualification for the track event finals will be based on timings, not finishing positions during the Heats.
- Students may qualify for a maximum of three individual finals, excluding relay events.
