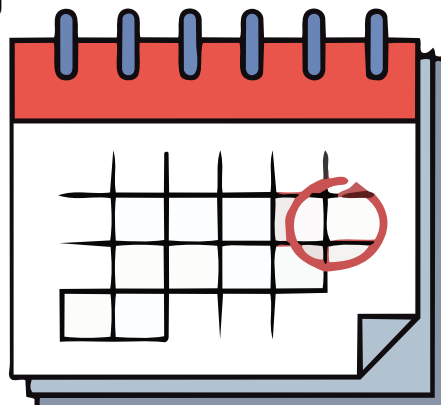

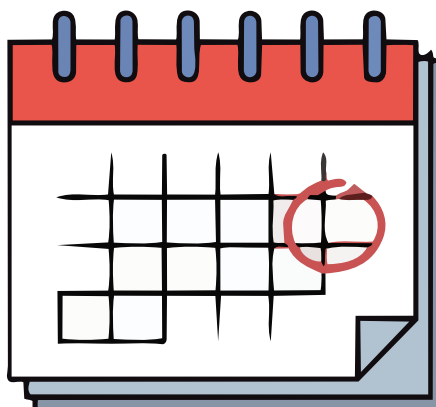

As always, thank you for your continued partnership and support. We look forward to sharing many more memorable experiences with our students and families over the coming weeks.

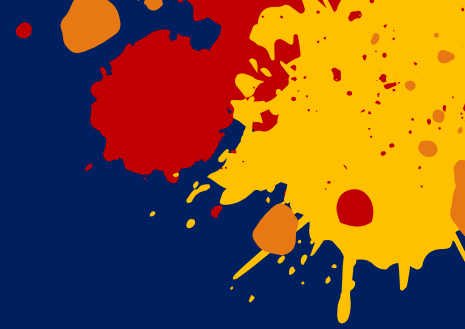
As we continue through an exciting term, we would like to remind families of the upcoming EY & PY PTC on Thursday 27 & Friday 28 August.

RACIAL HARMONY DAY AND ASSEMBLY

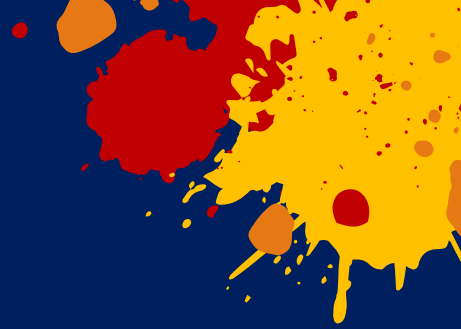

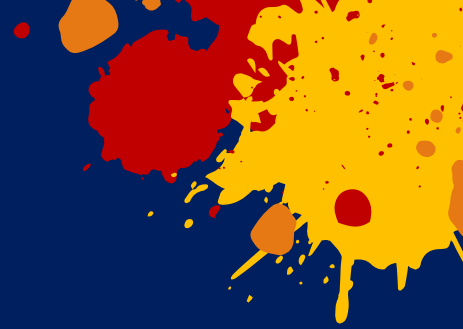

THE YOUTH ENTREPRENEURS PROGRAM (TYE)

Working over the past 10 months in The Youth Entrepreneurs Program (TYE) by TiE has been one of the most rewarding experiences of our high school journey. Throughout the program, we had the opportunity to learn directly from some of Singapore's most renowned entrepreneurs and investors, gaining invaluable insights into innovation, leadership, and building a business from the ground up.

As a team of six high school students, we conceptualized and designed an e-bike conversion kit from its very core, with each member taking ownership of distinct responsibilities that made the experience feel like running a real startup. Our efforts in winning the Regional Finals led us to qualify for the Global Semi-Finals, where we competed against the top 36 teams in the world in a 10-minute investor pitch to a panel of investors followed by 5 min Q&A.

Presenting alongside teams from different countries and witnessing the creativity, depth, and innovation behind their ideas broadened our perspective and challenged us to think more ambitiously about the future. Progressing through the Global Semi-Finals and being the top team in our track, we ultimately finished 4th in the world.

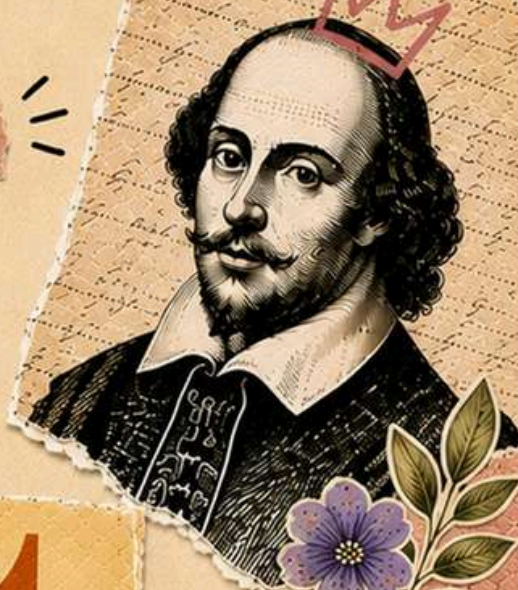
