Guidelines for Competitions

Competitions:

1. Antakshari Competition

- Theme – Bollywood Songs.
- Each group to consist of 2 to 4 participants, and it must include at least one NPSI parent.
- Participants should sing songs from Hindi movies or albums.
- Original compositions are not allowed for this competition.
- Each team will have a time limit for 30 seconds to start singing their song.

Criteria:

Participants will be evaluated based on their singing performance, and audience engagement.

2. Show Your Talent - Students Competition

- This competition is open to all NPSI students from Grades 2-12.

- Students can perform solo or in groups.
- Groups may consist of maximum 4 students.
- Each performance will have a time limit of 2 minutes.

- Theme – **Around the World in Style**.
- This competition is open to all NPSI Students, Parents & Grandparents.
- Each group may have 2 to 4 participants, and it must include at least 1 NPSI adult member.
- Participants can dress to represent different countries and cultures while showcasing confidence and creativity.
- Participants will present their outfits in a **ramp walk** format.
- Submit a **brief write-up** describing your outfit and the inspiration behind it for the emcee’s narration.
- Props are allowed but must be used meaningfully and creatively.

Criteria:

Creativity, originality, relevance to theme, stage presence and overall impact.

- Participants are allowed to use only the ingredients provided.
- Participants will also be provided with basic kitchen equipment but can also bring their own cutlery.
- No cooking will be allowed.
- Participants are welcome to bring a big plate to present their prepared dishes.

Criteria:

Planning, Creative use of ingredients, Taste and Presentation.

Creativity, neatness and overall presentation.

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9. Pot Decoration

- Each group can have maximum of 2 participants, and it must include at least 1 NPSI parent.
- All teams will be provided with a flower pot.
- Participants are required to bring all other materials needed for decorating the pot.
- Participants will be given 30 minutes to make the item.

Design, Neatness, Craftsmanship and Creativity.
