CRICKET TOURNAMENT – 8-A-Side (NPSI DADS’)

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- **Reporting Time:**

All teams must report by **7:30 AM sharp** at the venue. Teams that fail to report on time **will forfeit their match**, and points will be awarded to the team ready as per the fixture schedule.

PLAYER EQUIPMENT & ATTIRE

- **Required:** Bat, abdomen guard, gloves.
- **Optional:** Helmet.
- **Provided:** Match balls will be supplied by the school.
- **Attire:** All players must wear **cricket whites** or **team jerseys with white pants** and **sports shoes** (no spikes, no non covered shoes).
 - Players without proper attire will **not be allowed to play**.

TEAM COMPOSITION & SUBSTITUTIONS

- Teams must consist of **minimum 8 and maximum 10 players**.
- **8 players** play the match; **9th and 10th** may be used as fielding substitutes only. Substitutes **cannot bat, bowl, or keep wickets**.

MATCH FORMAT

- **Simultaneous Matches:**
4 matches will run concurrently across 2 fields using **overlapping innings** format.
No innings break will be given.
- **Innings Format:**
 - 6 bowlers must bowl 1 over each (one designated wicketkeeper and one non-bowler).
 - **Bowler run-ups** must be limited to **10 yards**, starting from the marked indicator.
 - **Wicketkeeper** must be designated before the start and **cannot bowl**.
- **Scoring & Rules:**
 - **Batsmen retire** at 20 runs and may return in the order of retirement if needed.
 - **Wides:** 2 extra runs; re-bowled only in the **last over**.
 - **No balls:** 2 extra runs + **Free Hit**; re-bowled in all cases.
 - **No LBWs or leg byes** allowed.
 - Matches ending in a draw or tie will be decided via a **4-ball bowl-out**.
- **Semi-Finals & Final:**
 - 7-over format (5 balls per over).
 - 7 different bowlers; wicketkeeper does not bowl.
- **All overs will be bowled from one end.**

RAIN & WEATHER POLICY

- Matches will **begin as soon as the lightning alarm stops**. Please report to the venue even if it's raining.
- **If weather interrupts play** (e.g. rain or lightning alarm), matches may be shortened (overs/balls).
- Games may be advanced or rescheduled based on field conditions and delays.
- Organisers reserve the right to **modify or cancel** matches in case of heavy rain or unsafe conditions.

TEAM SUBMISSIONS & CONDUCT

- Team captains must report to the **scorer's table 10 minutes prior** to their scheduled match and submit:
 - Final **team list**
 - **Batting and bowling order**
- One **reserve player** should be seated next to the official scorer during your game.
- Only the **designated team manager**, as listed on the registration form, may communicate with officials.
- **Match referee's decision is final.**
- All matches will follow **standard ICC rules**, except where modified by the rules above.

AWARDS & RECOGNITION

- **Medals** for the **top 2 teams**.
- **Bronze medals** for winners of the **Challenger's Final**.
- **Individual Awards:**
 - Best Batsman
 - Best Bowler
 - Best Fielder
 - Best Wicketkeeper
 - Most Promising Player
 - Player of the Tournament
 - Fair Play Award
